

LCF Safeguarding Guide for Under 16s- In-person

Venue

All events from Monday 27 June through to Wednesday 29 June will take place at Guildhall.

How should you prepare for a session?

- ✓ Pupils should read the pre-session information so they are prepared and will feel confident to take part and be able to get the most out of the event.
- ✓ Ensure you arrive 20 mins before the start of your session.
- ✓ 'Attendees for ALL SESSIONS must have a valid ticket (Teacher tickets will have the number of pupils attached to them noted by the organisers. Only the teacher ticket will need to be presented).
- ✓ Pupils must stay with their schoolteacher at all times.
- ✓ Pupils should alert their teacher or an LCF staff member of any problems they have.
- ✓ You must not take any photos of other young people who are attending the event.
- ✓ No food or beverages can be consumed onsite at the Guildhall
- ✓ It is important that you treat the facilitators of sessions and other young people in the session with courtesy and respect. You may be removed from a session if your behaviour is not in line with this.
- ✓ The session is for you to learn about careers, feel inspired and ask questions. So, please do join in all the conversations and interactive elements of the event.

- ✓ Please show your valid ticket at registration desk.
- ✓ Stay with your pupils the whole time.
- ✓ Choose your lunch space (recommendations for these are included within the information pack).
- ✓ Alert a LCF staff member of any problems you have.
