Venue

How should you prepare for a session?

- ✓ Attendees should read the pre-session information so they are prepared and will feel confident to take part and be able to get the most out of the event.
- ✓ Aim to arrive 15 mins before the start of your session
- ✓ 'Attendees for ALL SESSIONS must have a valid student or teacher ticket (Teacher tickets will have the number of pupils attached to them noted by the organisers. Only the teacher ticket will need to be presented. Student tickets should be shown and checked individually)
- ✓ Attendees should alert their teacher or a LCF staff member of any problems they have.
- ✓ You must not take any photos of other young people who are attending the event.
- ✓ No food or beverages can be consumed onsite at the Guildhall
- ✓ It is important that you treat the facilitators of sessions and others in the session with courtesy and respect. You may be removed from a session if your behaviour is not in line with this.
- ✓ The session is for you to learn about careers, feel inspired and ask questions. So, please do join in all the conversations and interactive elements of the event.
